Call for participants: *Qualitative Researcher Journeys*

When learning about qualitative research methodology, novice researchers want to see and use practical examples. Yet open data sets and example materials are often so project specific that learners find it difficult to relate the examples to their potential research designs, and those teaching have to grapple with generalising and simplifying research processes with material that was never designed with teaching in mind.

This *Qualitative Researcher Journey* project aims to generate a pseudonymised open access data-set on the theme of qualitative research that can be used in the teaching and learning of qualitative research methods, including our software and learning materials. In keeping with Quirkos's philosophy of accessibility, open means open – the data-set will be made freely available via our website.

Method: Semi-structured interview in English, via Audio call (Zoom or similar)

Time: Approx. 1 hour

Incentive and reward: Opportunity to reflect on your journey from a novice researcher to your current practice as a qualitative researcher or teacher. Receipt of open access data-set and other example material for your use e.g. in your teaching

Who: If you identify as a qualitative researcher and have more than five years' experience, Quirkos wants to hear about your research journey, where-ever you are based in the world, whether you use qualitative analysis software, or not.
